

Clear Creek Conservation District is offering rain barrels to promote water quality by reducing storm water runoff. Rain barrels are also used to collect rain water to water plants and gardens.



Rain barrels (natural/unpainted color— barrels are black in color) are made from recycled food grade barrels and have traveled many thousands of miles. They have been thoroughly cleaned inside and out, and have had several coats of a UV polish applied. They may have some scratches and scrapes, which should be considered as part of the “character” of the recycled barrels. The barrels have a screw on top with one inch holes, screen mesh to keep out debris and mosquitoes, three top over-flow male hose connections with caps, a nylon spigot, and a bottom drain plug. The overflow fittings allow excess water to be diverted to remote areas such as a garden or flower beds. The nylon spigot is shipped inside the barrel and will need to be screwed into the pre-installed plastic fitting. The spigot should only be installed finger tight. The nylon spigot can be interchanged with the bottom drain plug if desired.
